Thought you and your fellow Springfield Rotarians would like to know that the two proposals which I presented to the R.I. Council on Legislation on behalf of your club were both approved.

I made the presentation and motion on the change from appointment to election of The Rotary Foundation Board of Trustees. Council delegates approved it 464-45, one of the biggest margins of the over 200 issues considered. Springfield was one of about 15 co-sponsors of the proposal to reduce the Nominating Committee for R.I. from 34 to 17. A PDG from Kansas was the prime proposer and I was the first support speaker. The enactment was approved 346-167.

Macomb's resolution to make the secondary motto "One profits most who serves best" was also approved so D-6460 was 3-0 with its proposals. Of the total of 219 proposals brought before the Council, delegates approved 65. I'm very pleased with the results.

PRID Bob Stuart did a fantastic job in his high pressure role of Chairman of the Constitution and By-Laws committee. He and his team were called upon repeatedly to make prompt rulings on the validity of numerous matters that Council delegates brought up on a wide variety of topics.
