

How to Host an Inbound Student

YE is a Year Commitment

- The Program is August - July or Jan - Dec
- Inbounds need 2-3 Host Families
- YEOs, YECs, Host Families must be vetted,
- Two clubs can share costs and duties
- This is one of RI's most important programs.



Step One: Fill out a Commitment Form requesting to host; Provide an idea of gender, country.

Step Two: Appoint a YEO, Get permission from your High School, Find your first host family.

Step Three: Your *YEO gets tested, listed with Dept of State, becomes one of the elite of YE.

Step Four: Your Host Family fills out an application, gets trained, starts emailing Inbound.

Step Five: Rotary Club enjoys the benefits of Youth Exchange.

Cost: \$3,000-\$3500 for the Inbound year, usually August – July. (Club pays for allowance, lunch, transportation to Fun Weekends, school supplies, an administrative fee of \$1,000 to cover Central States membership, attendance for Grand Rapids, Fun Weekends.)

*YEO must be a Rotarian who will usher the Inbound through club activities and interact with Host parents, school, sports activities. The YEO should have a committee of committed Rotarians including an appointed Youth Exchange Counselor who also can interact with the Inbound.
